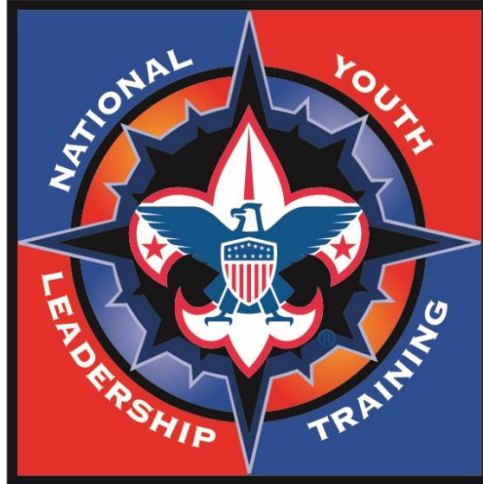

The National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) course supports Scoutmasters with their responsibility to train youth leaders. The Chattahoochee Council is seeking Scouts to serve as NYLT staff. Serving on NYLT staff is widely recognized as a remarkable and pivotal leadership experience for many Scouts during their journey along the Scouting trail.

Scouts specially selected and invited to serve on NYLT staff will change the lives of their fellow Scouts by helping them become better leaders in their Troop or Crew. NYLT staff will hone the leadership skills they gained when they attended NYLT by facilitating the course for their peers and gaining a deeper understanding of the course material.

Scouts should apply if they meet all the following requirements:

1. Discovery, Star, Life, or Eagle Scout and at least 14 years of age by the course start date.
2. Completed NYLT as a participant.
3. Lives by the Scout Oath and Law, sets a positive example, wears the full Scout uniform, and will adhere to staff standards described in the application.
4. Fully committed to attending all Staff Development sessions and the entire week of the NYLT course (see attached dates).
5. Must pay the staff fee for food, materials, and course staff items (fee in development, comparable to 2023).
6. Supported by their unit leader to serve on NYLT Staff. The CONFIDENTIAL Unit Leader's recommendation is required for applicant consideration.
7. Completes a staff interview (see attached dates).
