- 5. Must pay the staff fee for food, materials, and course staff items (fee in development, comparable to 2023).
- 6. Supported by their unit leader to serve on NYLT Staff. The CONFIDENTIAL Unit Leader's recommendation is required for applicant consideration.
- 7. Completes a staff interview (see attached dates).
